ACUTE CARE FOR NURSING* \$750 - PAYMENT ARRANGEMENT AVAILABLE

This course allows students to perform CNA skills and duties in the acute care (hospital) setting. The course includes instruction in communication skills, patient observation and reporting, and reinforcement of Certified Nurse Assisting procedures. The course includes an additional emphasis on the specialized acute care areas of medical/surgical, pediatrics, labor and delivery, nursery, mother/baby care, rehabilitation orthopedics, and cardiac/telemetry. *Must hold a current California CNA or LVN license to enroll. Proof of diploma/GED and assessment NOT required.

HOME HEALTH AIDE* \$300

This course prepares students for employment in the home or hospice care setting as a Certified Home Health Aide (CHHA). Emphasis is on providing basic nursing care safely, efficiently and economically. Students learn to work in various home situations, and plan and implement nursing care based on the needs of the client. Students will become knowledgeable of illnesses and disabilities as related to the life cycle. *Must hold a current California CNA or LVN license to enroll. Proof of diploma/GED and assessment NOT required.

NURSE ASSISTANT* \$1900 - PAYMENT ARRANGEMENT AVAILABLE

February 4, 2014 - June 19, 2014 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Tuesday 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m., Thursday

This course prepares students to take the state competency exam for Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA). With an emphasis on caring for geriatric patients in a skilled nursing facility, students will learn personal patient care skills such as feeding, dressing and grooming. Students will learn to observe, measure and record patient vital signs as well as patient intake and output. *Social Security card required. Student must pass a criminal clearance background check.

INSURANCE SERVICES INTERNSHIP \$1000 - PAYMENT ARRANGEMENT AVAILABLE February 3, 2014 - June 18, 2014

9:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m., Monday – Friday

This course is designed for individuals interested in business and finance, with an emphasis on the insurance industry. It prepares students for entry-level positions such as Insurance Claims Clerk or Insurance Policy Processing Clerk, and also includes instruction that can lead to the long-term goal of becoming a Licensed Insurance Sales Agent. Students will learn about various insurance products including property and casualty, health, disability, long-term care, and life insurance. Additional instructional units will include state and federal regulations, the role insurance plays in managing risks, legal principles of insurance, ethics and social responsibilities, and the benefits of a career in the insurance industry. To follow the career path to Licensed Insurance Sales Agent, employer sponsorship is required to take the licensing exams.
