This is a combination course that consists of Nurse Assistant, Acute Care for Nursing, and Home Health Aide training.

Instruction includes:

- Nurse Assistant training to prepare students to take the California competency exam to become a Certified Nurse Assistant (CNA).
- Students will be prepared to become a Certified Home Health Aide.
- Patient observation and reporting, communication skills, and taking vital signs.
- Patient care skills such as feeding, hygiene care, and helping with walking and exercise.
- Training in illnesses and disabilities as related to the life cycle.
- Emphasis on acute care areas may include emergency, intensive care, medical/surgical, and cardiac.

Admission Requirements

- High school or equivalent transcript.
- Successful completion of required assessment test.
- Current government-issued photo ID.
- Social Security Card or Right to Work Documentation.

Program Requirements

- Maintain a minimum 76% grade average and a 93% attendance rate.
- Basic keyboarding and computer skills to facilitate learning of software.
- Clinical hours included in program.
- Fingerprinting and background check will be required.

Included in the Cost of Program Fees

- Textbooks.
- Two uniform sets and one lab coat.
- American Heart Association Basic Life Support (BLS) CPR and First Aid training and card.
- Nurse Assistant Certification Exam.
- Fingerprinting.
